Founded just two years after Academic Hall was built, the marching band has more history than the Missouri State Flag and the University Alma Mater! The SEMO Marching Band is one of the largest student organizations on campus.

The band performs at all home football games, leads campus spirit rallies, marches in parades, and showcases their talents at special high school marching band festivals. They have continued their traditions of excellence with performances like those at the 2023 Bands of America Super Regional in Indianapolis, and the 2024 Bands of America Super Regional in St. Louis. 
